6. We will monitor our performance in respect to health and safety requirements, Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) Legislation, and the environment in general. We will have due regard for the concerns of our employees, customers, suppliers, contractors, local communities and the public at large in establishing and maintaining safe working standards.
